STUDENT DRIVING PRIVILEGE RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

Students who drive automobiles on school campuses will be responsible for all accidents, injury or damage caused by their driving of automobiles or to the contents therein.

In order to supervise student drivers, principals shall obtain completed student driving permit application before issuing a parking pass to a student. The application will require the home phone number, the student's driver license number, the tag number, the make, model, year, and color of the student's automobile; and the student's liability insurance carrier and policy number.

The student must present a valid driver's license, proof of insurance and current make and motor vehicle registration to drive on any Scottsboro city schools property. Liability insurance must meet the state minimums. Any change in the foregoing documents SHALL be immediately reported to the school administrator or designee. Failure to maintain current license, insurance and registration SHALL result in cancellation of driving privileges.

Any vehicle entering any Scottsboro city schools grounds is subject to a vehicle search by the School Resource Officer or School Officials at any time. Contraband items found in motor vehicles may result in suspension, expulsion and/or arrest (e.g. but not limited to weapons (including guns), drugs and controlled substances, alcohol etc.).

All students who drive on campus shall be required to follow the school regulations:

*All vehicles operated by students or parked on the school grounds must be registered with the school and must display the current parking pass at all times the vehicle is on campus. The pas shall be displayed on the rear view mirror.

*Parking is strictly limited to the student parking area and to the specific space assigned. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

*There will be no loitering in the parking area before, during or after school. Students must exit vehicles and enter the building as soon as they arrive at school and must leave immediately after school ends.

*The speed limit on the Scottsboro High School campus is 15 MPH and is conspicuously posted. Speeding is prohibited.

*Reckless driving will not be tolerated and could result in a State of Alabama citation, heavy fines and the accumulation of six points against the student's Alabama driving record.

*It is illegal to make left turns onto the access road at the Highway 72 intersection during peak traffic/restricted times. This may result in a state of Alabama citation because the violation occurs while moving from a private drive (school access road) onto a City street.

*Driving on any grassy areas rather than using the parking lot exits is prohibited. Offenders may be charged with criminal mischief and required to reimburse the school for the damages.

*Seat belts are required by state law and are mandatory while operating a motor vehicle on school grounds.

*Any person found operating a motor vehicle on school grounds while under the influence of drugs or alcohol SHALL be charged accordingly and shall bear both school and legal consequences.

*Violation of any of the above rules/regulations (unless stipulated otherwise), may result in a local school citation and a \$10.00 fine, loss of privileges and/or the vehicle being toward at the owner's expense.
